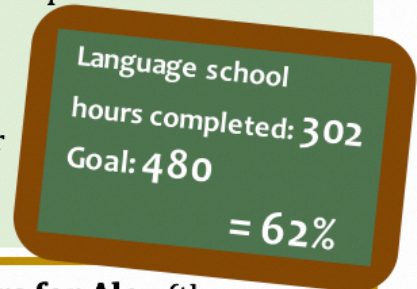

The Lord has given us several opportunities to **participate in evangelism** at nearby parks with local Romanian believers! Ben has gone out with two different young men on a few Friday evenings, and with a group of about six individuals on the first Saturday of April. The Lord arranged for Marie to come along for the Saturday outreach and on one of the Friday evenings. Not only do we continue to develop language as we listen to the Romanians share the Gospel, but we also get language practice as we fellowship with them. Ben has had several key conversations with the two Christian young men on Friday evenings, challenging them to think more Biblically about different topics. The Lord allowed Marie to begin training a young Romanian lady how to hand out John and Romans. *Continue to pray for wisdom and humility to invest in those who will invest in others.*



We finished our mid-term exams for Romanian **language level B1** on April 24, a week before the school closed for both the Romanian holiday, Labor Day (May 1<sup>st</sup>), and the Orthodox Easter weekend (May 3-7). We are so grateful for our Argentinean babysitter who takes good care of our kids while we are in class. In April she asked Marie for some family advice that led to a Gospel conversation!

We learned a little about how Romanian Orthodox priests prepare for Easter week while talking with our language school teacher – who is married to a priest!



**Thank you for your prayers for Alex** (the young Romanian man that Ben has been discipling) and for his health crisis over the last few months. He went from barely being able to shuffle around with the help of a cane, to walking around town, sharing the Gospel with others! As his health improves, he has again been meeting with Ben for discipleship, specifically learning about maintaining one's spiritual passion for God. *Please continue to pray for wisdom in this relationship and for his health to be fully restored.*

Ben also had an opportunity in April to join Alex for a quick weekend trip to a church about 2 hours away. The time in the car provided opportunity for language practice and informal discipleship.
